## Cookies for Kairos – Bakers Needed

The Kairos Weekend retreat for 36 Christian men incarcerated at Perry Correctional Institution in Pelzer is April 18–21. To help to bring these men to the table is the bottomless bowl of cookies and home-cooked meals brought in by local churches. **Deacon John is on the Kairos Presentation Team and needs support from our parish to contribute 150 dozen home-made cookies.** Since many privileges for others are suspended those four days, the team also gives a dozen cookies (with a Scripture verse in the bag) to all 800+ men, as well as all the correction officers at Perry on both Friday and Saturday nights. To that end, the Team needs almost 4,000 dozen cookies. If you are willing, please consider baking 3, 6, or 10 dozen cookies to be delivered to the church by noon on April 17.
